Covid-19 Policy and Protocols

FBU is dedicated to ensuring the safety, health, and betterment of any student-athletes that we have the opportunity to interact with during our events. This past Summer, we collectively had over 3,000 student-athletes and family members attend our FBU Atlanta Regional Camp, FBU Texas Showdown and FBU Top Gun Showcase. We were able to effectively run these events with no issues due to the proactive measures and policies that we instituted pertaining to Covid-19.

We are 100% committed to moving forward with the 2020 FBU National Championship Tournament. Our team is consistently monitoring the specific health updates/guidelines that are provided by the CDC to ensure that our policies and protocols are up to date. We are also working closely with State/Local officials where we have FBUNC Teams.

While certain aspects of the Tournament may need to be flexible this year, that does not change our commitment to providing a first-class experience for all the student-athletes who have the opportunity to participate.

A) Pre-Tournament Guidelines

- Athletes, staff, and all participants are required to stay home if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms prior to the start of an FBUNC Event:
 - Cough, chills, and sore throat
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Repeated shaking with chills
 - Headache
 - Loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea
 - Feeling feverish or having a temperature equal or greater than 100
- b. All student-athletes participating in a local FBUNC Tryout or Practice, must sign the FBUNC Covid-19 Waiver & Release Form and also follow the “stay-at-home” guidelines as listed above
 - *If no waiver is signed, you will NOT be able to participate in any FBUNC Event*

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B) Tournament-Specific Guidelines

- Any individual at an FBUNC event that is displaying symptoms of Covid-19 will be asked to immediately isolate and vacate the premises and encouraged to seek medical care
- All attendees should cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue if possible, or the inside of your elbow. Throw used tissues in nearest trash can and immediately wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or hand sanitizer
- Any and all attendees (staff, players, parents, etc.) of an FBUNC event will be recommended to wear a protective mask and gloves throughout duration of event – all FBUNC Staff and Volunteers will wear protective masks and gloves throughout duration of event
- Any and all attendees (staff, players, parents, etc.) of an FBUNC event will be required to thoroughly wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer before entering the event area
- All FBUNC Staff, Volunteers and Athletes must have temperature below 100.4 degrees to participate
- During Regional Round games, attendees will be limited to friends and family members of the teams participating and must leave at the conclusion of their game
- Attendees will be encouraged to adhere to 6-ft social distancing guidelines throughout the duration of the event and FBU will work with local venues on blocking off every other row in the bleachers – families may remain seated together
- Sanitation stations will be set-up throughout event location – including all main entry/exit points of event
- It is highly advised that all attendees avoid contact with eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands/gloves
- It is highly advised that all players sanitize their hands BEFORE departing the event
- FBU equipment that is utilized (*game balls, etc.*) will be thoroughly disinfected between games
- Any individual who is blatantly disregarding the guidelines outlined throughout duration of the event will be asked to vacate the premises immediately
- Athletes are encouraged to bring their own water bottles; no water sharing will be allowed. Gatorade will be available, but the final process surrounding distribution is still being finalized

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
