Code of Conduct

It is of paramount importance that all members of the FBU National Championship family demonstrate the highest standards of ethics, sportsmanship, respect for being a guest in your hotel and adhere to our core values. Those values include trustworthiness, integrity, responsibility, accountability, and fairness. All FBU National Championship participants - coaches, players, and parents/guardians - must abide by all applicable game, competition, and house rules -- without exception.

All players, coaches, game officials, and administrators must be treated with mutual respect. Profanity or obscene gestures will not be tolerated at any time. Offensive remarks of a sexual or racial nature, trash-talking, taunting, boastful celebrations or other actions that demean individuals or the sport are not allowed. Players should demonstrate concern for others and never engage in reckless behavior that might injure themselves or cause injury to opponents. Our coaches are role models and must set an example – in particular, complaining about decisions or arguing with game officials during or after the game is strictly prohibited. It is a privilege to be involved with this event.

Adherence to the Hotel House Rules set forth below is also a requirement of being a member of the FBU National Championship family. If FBU leadership receives a complaint from a hotel about an individual's behavior, or a team's behavior, it will be considered a violation of the FBU Code of Conduct subject to the appropriate penalties.

Violations of the FBU Code of Conduct may result in the suspension or termination of the participation privilege – as an individual, or in extreme instances, as a team, and all such decisions are at the sole discretion of Football University.

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Hotel House Rules

- ❖ Be respectful of all other guests at the hotel!
- ❖ 10:30PM curfew for all players with the exception of an FBUNC late night event. This means all athletes should be in their own room
- ❖ No running up and down the hallways or loitering in the halls. Social activity should be in the lobby
- ❖ No running or other forms of horseplay in any public areas, including the swimming pool
- ❖ No yelling while indoors
- ❖ No destroying or tampering with any hotel property
- ❖ No playing loud music or television (keep the volume down)
- ❖ No pranks of any nature, wrestling or any kind of roughhousing which may result in damage to property or injury to fellow teammates
- ❖ No prank phone calls inside or outside of the hotel
- ❖ Rooms should be kept tidy with garbage in garbage cans and the room should be left in the same condition as it was when you arrived
- ❖ No jumping on the beds or damaging furniture
- ❖ No cleats worn inside the hotel at any time
- ❖ Any damage to a room, or to hotel property, will be the responsibility of the athlete and his family
- ❖ Adherence to this Code of Conduct and the Hotel House Rules will be monitored by FBU Staff, Hotel Staff and the Team leadership with any violations being reported to FBU
